morning bell to ring.

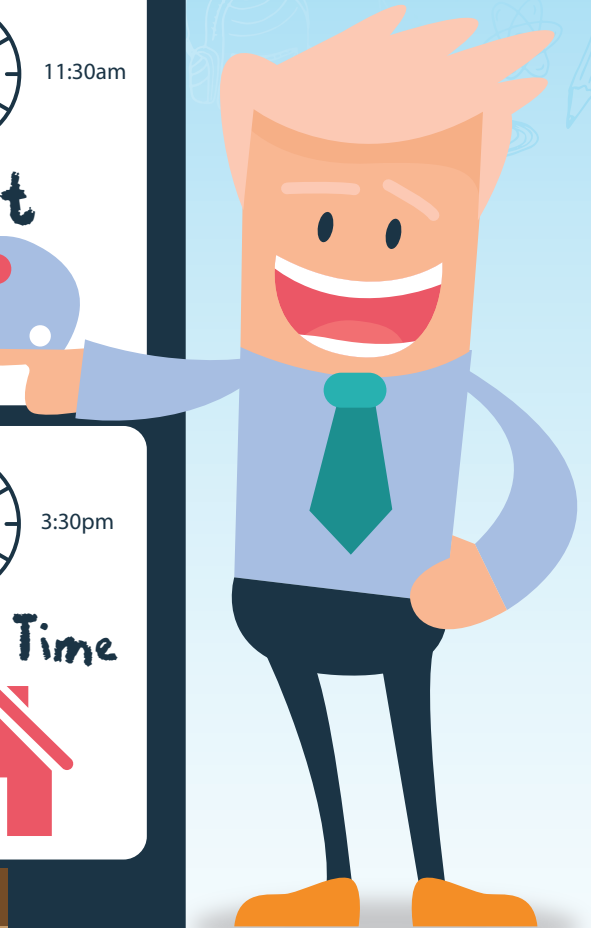


When the bell goes
